



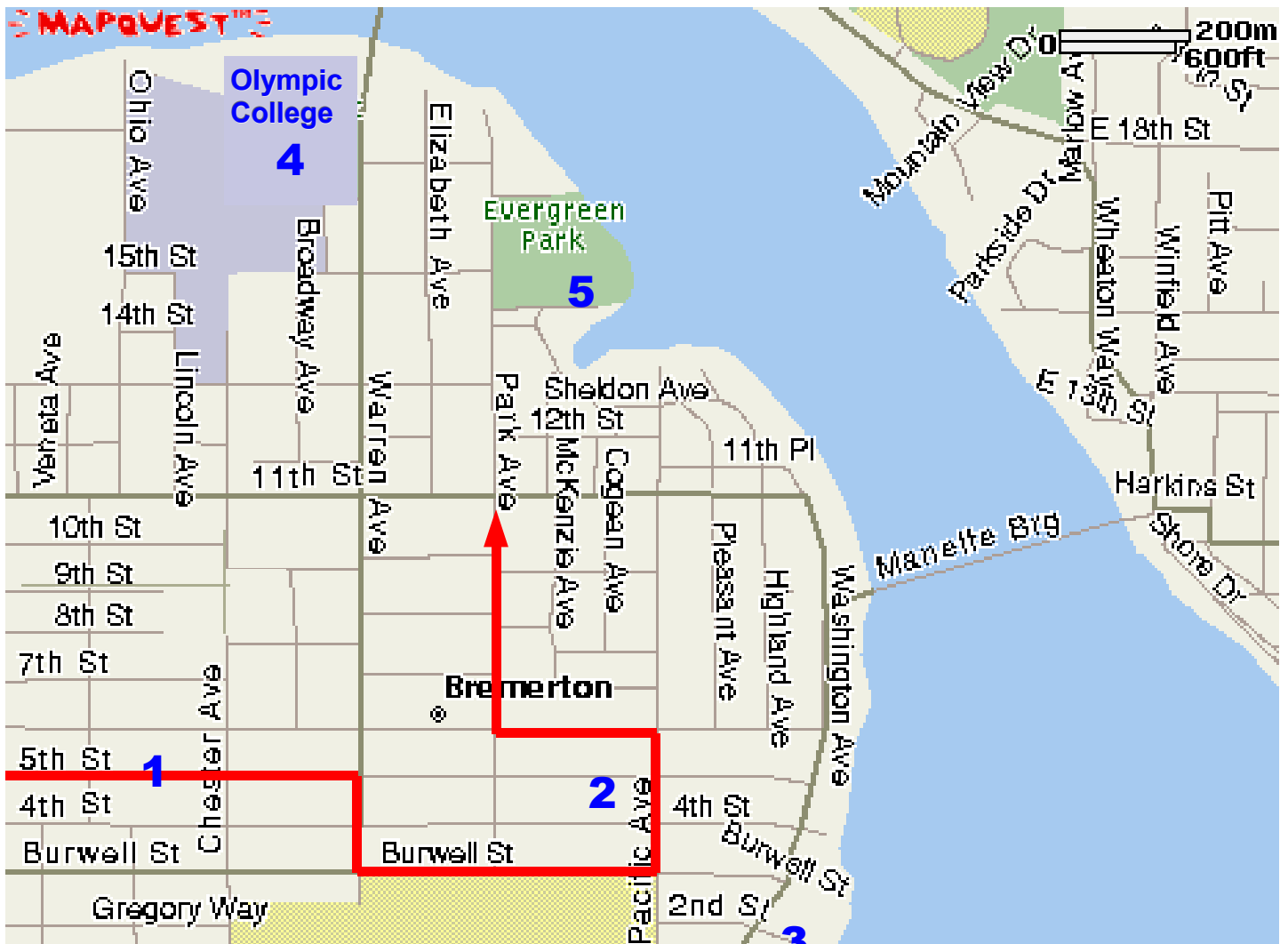

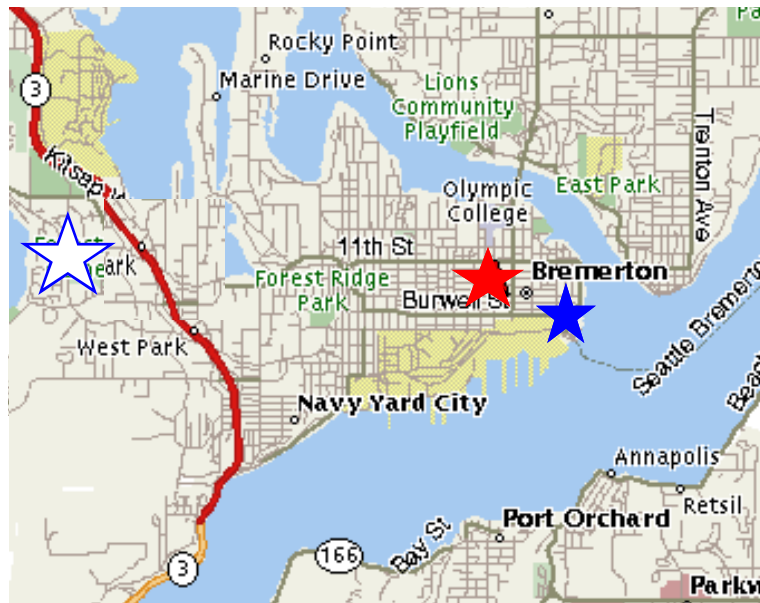

Directions to Kitsap HydroFest

Take Kitsap Way Exit off Highway 3
 Head west for a mile or two (up the hill)
 Park at Cascade Natural Gas Building (on left) or
 Puget Sound Energy (on right)
 Shuttle busses to Kitsap Lake are available

Directions to Downtown Bremerton

From the South
 Highway 16 towards Bremerton
 When you see the Navy ships, take the right fork
 when Highway 3 splits (follow signs to
 ferry)
 Make a right on Burwell
 Parade entries: Left on Naval Avenue (2nd light)
 Spectators: Left on Warren Avenue (3rd light)
 Park along side streets

From the North

Highway 3
 towards
 Bremerton
 Kitsap Way exit
 Left at exit (towards downtown Bremerton/ferry)
 Stay on Kitsap Way for about 1 mile and turn left on
 11th Street
 Parade entries: Right on Naval Avenue to staging
 Spectators: Right on Warren Avenue
 park along side streets
 OR
 Stay on 11th Street and park along side streets

From Seattle

Take the Washington State Ferry to Bremerton
 Walk north on Washington
 Left on Burwell, Fourth, Fifth or Sixth
