CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD FUNCTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES

The senior club officer is the Chairman of the Board; his/her duties are to chair Board meetings, serve as an adjudicator, and manage the daily administration of the WCWA. The Chairman will conduct Board meetings at least once a quarter. The Chairman will govern according to parliamentary procedure. The Chairman will appoint committees as required. The Chairman is not a “President” and has no powers beyond those conferred by this Constitution or the Bylaws unless expressly approved by the member units of the WCWA. The Chairman has no vote on the Board except in the case of a tie. If the Chairman is a Commander or Leader, the tie-breaking vote passes to the Vice-Chairman.

UNION BATTALION COMMANDER FUNCTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES

The Union Battalion Commander serves on the Board as a military advisor. He reports to the Board on matters regarding troop strengths and relative abilities of the Union Battalion and offers advice and opinions on any subject affecting that military branch of the WCWA. The Union Battalion Commander shall be the highest authority over Union military impressionists at field events. The Union Battalion Commander shall be the highest authority over civilian impressionists who camp within the geographic boundaries of the Union military camp at field events. The Union Battalion Commander may appoint staff, subject to confirmation by the General Board, to aid in the implementation of Union Battalion policies. The Union Battalion Commander has no vote on the Board.
